

Homeland Security grants awarded

The county was recently awarded \$633,670 from the state's Homeland Security Grant Program and another \$193,158 from the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program for equipment, training and exercise costs.

According to officials, the funds will be used for "preventing, deterring, responding, and recovering from threats and incidents of terrorism involving the use of chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear and explosive weapons and cyber attacks."

The Livingston County Board of Commissioners had approved a request in June to submit applications to the state for grants totaling \$826,000.
