COMPLAINT UNDER SECTION 26-A OF DOG LAW

Now comes _____, Plaintiff, pursuant to P.A. 1919, No. 339, Section 287.286A, and makes a sworn complaint that:

1. _____ of _____ is the owner of the dog concerned in this complaint.

2. That one of the following has occurred concerning said dog:

- A. After January 10th and before June 15th, said dog being over 6 months old is running at large, unaccompanied by its owner, or engaged in lawful hunting and not under the reasonable control of its owner, without a license attached to the collar on such dog, or;
- B. That said dog has destroyed property or habitually trespassed in a damaging way on property of persons other than the owner, or;
- C. That said dog has attacked or bitten a person, or;
- D. That said dog shows vicious habits and molests passerby when lawfully on the public highway, or;
- E. That said dog is running at large contrary to provisions of P.A. 1919, No. 339.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff asks that the court:

- A. Issue summons to show cause why such dog should not be killed.
- B. Order on such hearing that said dog be destroyed or confined to the premises of the owner.
- C. That in the event the owner disobeys said order, that he shall be liable to punishment in accord with Section 287.286 of P.A. 1919, Act 339.
- D. That costs be taxed against the owner of said dog.
